You made Radiothon a record year.

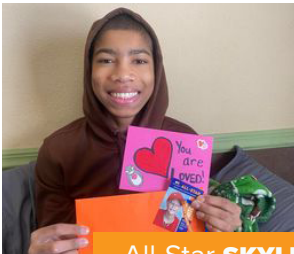
Together, we raised **\$423,629** during Pinky Swear's 10th annual Radiothon in December to help even more families facing childhood cancer.
