# The Original Pinky Swear Promise

After 9-year-old Mitch Chepokas from Chanhassen, Minnesota, was diagnosed with terminal bone cancer, he spent 10 months in the hospital. Recognizing that his own time was limited, Mitch took all the money from his own savings account and, with the help of his dad, gave the entire \$6,000 away to other kids in the hospital that he felt needed it more: kids that were also being treated for cancer.

Although Mitch was only 9, he was defined by a generous spirit and an empathetic soul. Mitch made his dad promise, through a father-and-son pinky swear, that the financial and emotional support he showed for kids with cancer and their families that winter night would continue after he had passed away.

The Pinky Swear Foundation exists because of that pinky swear promise.

# Pinky Swear Programs

The hardships inflicted on families because of childhood cancer are often not quantifiable. The financial burden of increased expenses – often while income is decreased due to reduced work hours, lost jobs, or unpaid, extended leave – can be overwhelming. Pinky Swear Foundation's programs provide immediate help and priceless stress relief to families in need. Since 2003, Pinky Swear Foundation has supported families' quality of life with direct financial aid for basic needs and through experiences that create emotional support including:




#### **Orange Envelope Program**

Pinky Swear Foundation is here for families with a child who has been newly diagnosed with cancer with a virtual 'hug' and a financial gift delivered right to their mailbox.



#### **All-Star Fund**

A fund that puts food on the table, covers car payments, mortgage and rent payments, and whatever needs a family has while caring for a child with cancer.

#### **Pinky Swear Pantry**

# All-Star Jackson

"Jackson was a typical three-year-old boy who loved playing outside and learning" explained Jackson's mom.

Then, in 2018, Jackson faced constant migraines which resulted in nausea, staggering, and slurred speech. After multiple tests, Jackson's family learned what had been causing Jackson's symptoms: a brain tumor.

"After receiving the diagnosis, as a family, we had to put our lives on hold," shared Jackson's mom. She could no longer provide childcare for other families – resulting in a loss of income for the family – and was forced to put her schooling on hold. Taking care of Jackson became a full-time job.

"Worst of all, Jackson did not understand what was happening to him and why he had to go through all of this."

Doctors successfully removed the mass from Jackson's brain, but the surgery caused the left side of his brain to go into "sleep mode". It took Jackson four months to re-learn how to walk, talk, and dress himself.

"Pinky Swear has been a huge factor in our family's social and financial recovery," Jackson's mom expressed. "We received an Orange Envelope with a small financial gift and other materials about their programs. It was reassuring to know that we had not been forgotten and that we were not alone."

Jackson is currently thriving in his Spanish-immersion kindergarten program and enjoys learning through jigsaw puzzles, mazes, and math. He has made new friends who are also battling cancer at the Pinky Swear Foundation Kids Triathlon and the All-Star Holiday Party. He still has yearly MRI's but there have been no further concerns since his surgery.

> "Pinky Swear Foundation has become an integral part of our support system for Jackson," expressed Jackson's mom. "The foundation has a genuine concern for Jackson and our family. We are so happy to be involved with Pinky Swear and the wonderful people who support it."

# A Letter from an All-Star Mom...

"Cal loved cars, trains, and airplanes. He loved playing outside and getting completely sweaty. He loved jumping, biking, and his dog. Cal also really loved his sister. They hardly ever argued, and he would play dolls with her without hesitation. He had an unforgettable laugh - the kind that made you look up from what you are doing to see his face.

Cal was not afraid of anything. He gritted his teeth when he needed his port accessed and closed his eyes. Cal never complained about his chemotherapy or hospital stays. I am confident the main reason was he was always with us. One of us had to work and care for Annabelle, but most nights in the hospital, we still had dinner together. Cal never cried for us, because we were always with him.

He was happy, easy, lovable, laughable, and adorable. Nearly every day of his 5 years.

When we lost Cal, we put much of our efforts and finances into trying to find cures for childhood cancer. Pinky Swear has opened our eyes to others that are suffering with heavy needs while battling childhood cancer. We know honoring Cal was the Larson family's initial intention behind this momentous gift to Pinky Swear, but we are really starting to feel that our heavenly son was maybe behind this before we knew it was happening! There is nothing more that Cal would have wanted as part of his legacy than to help promote, support, and give hope to a loving family.

Tim and I feel so grateful to be a part of Pinky Swear. We want to help every family going through cancer be able to physically be with their child and for their financial anxieties to be lessened."

September is Childhood Cancer Awareness Month during which we honor the thousands of families across the country who are impacted by pediatric cancer.






